



BUNKER HILL - MCGRAWSVILLE PROJECT

Wabash Valley Power Alliance, Miami-Cass REMC's wholesale power supplier, is proposing to construct a new, approximately 7-mile 69 kV transmission line to improve energy reliability for local communities in North Central Indiana. The new line will connect two substations in Miami County. The proposed in-service date for the project is first quarter of 2022.

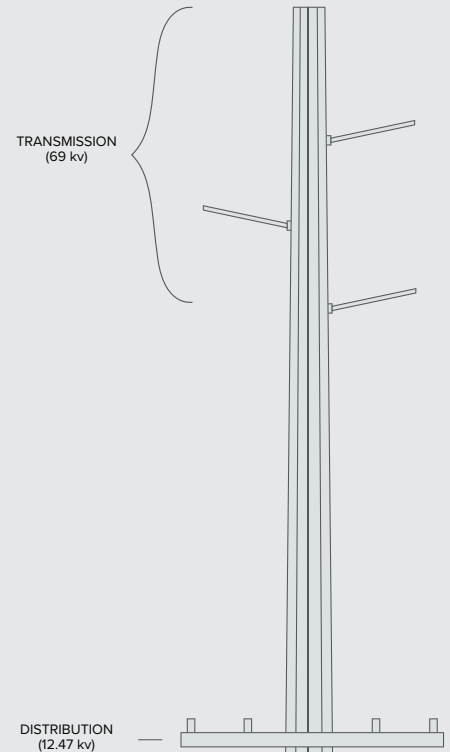

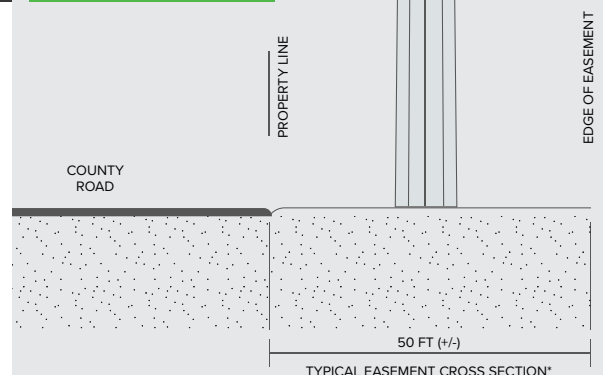


Typical 69 kV Steel Monopole Structures

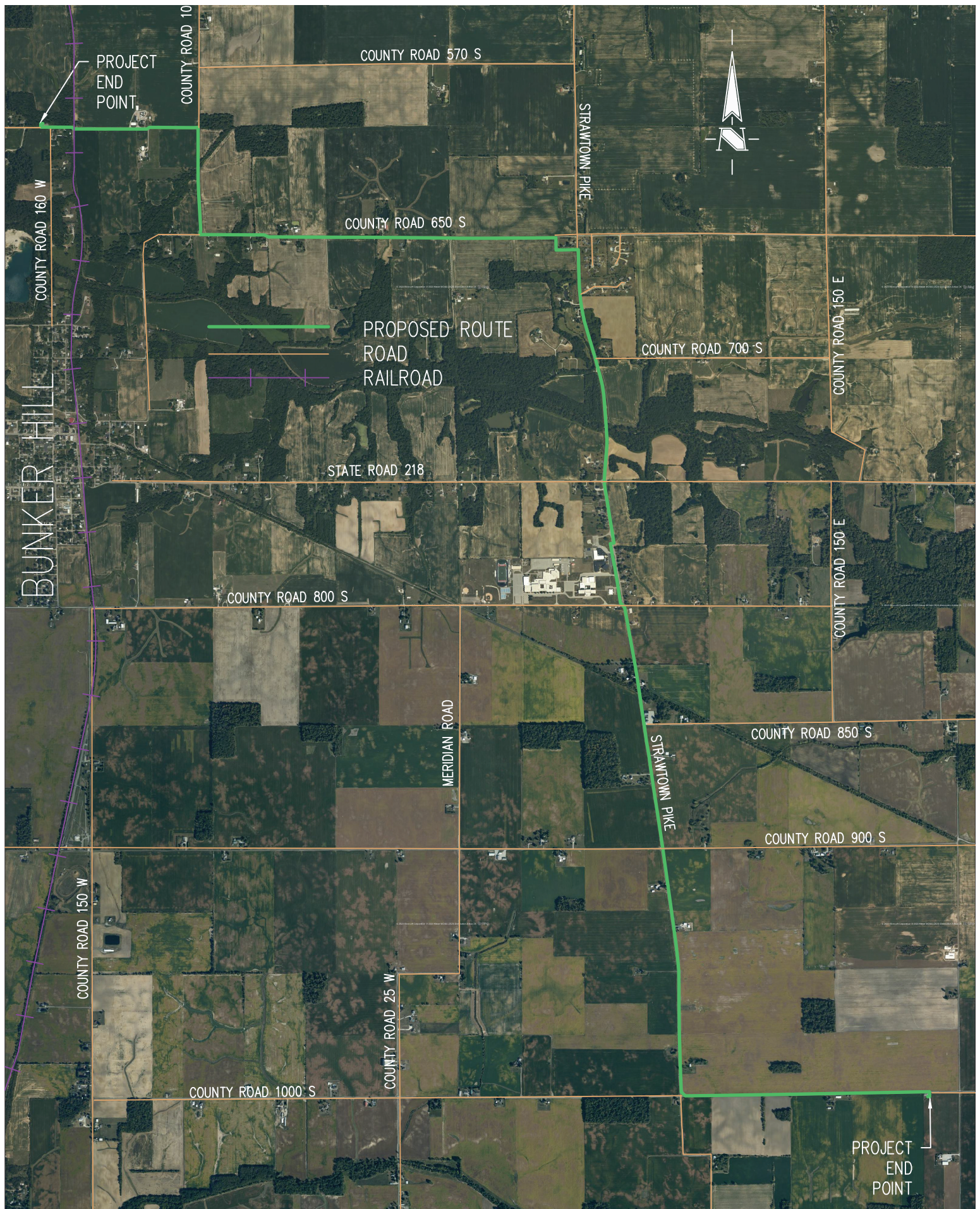
